

RETARGETING OF ELECTRICITY SUBSIDIES FOR THE PERIOD 1 JANUARY TO 30 JUNE 2024:

85% OF DOMESTIC CUSTOMERS ON THE PENINSULA ARE NOT AFFECTED

Imbalance Cost Pass-Through (ICPT) rebate and surcharge rates for domestic customers and non-domestic customers effective **1 January until 30 June 2024:**

Domestic Customers (Tariff A)

ICPT Charges

Electricity Consumption up to 600 kWh

Rebate 2 sen/kWh

Electricity Consumption between 601 – 1,500 kWh

No surcharge

Electricity Consumption above 1,500 kWh
