## Power outage in KK areas again

KOTA KINABALU: Residents and business operators in several parts of Luyang here had to endure more than two hours of power outage which began at 1.55pm on Sunday.

About eight areas in Luyang, including City Mall shopping complex, were affected by the power outage due to a trip from a feeder located at Star City, Api-Api.

Power in six areas were fully restored at about 3.55pm, while the rest were restored at 4.30pm.

Power outage was also reported in Kg Tanjung Aru Lama and Jalan Sempelang at about 7.35pm, followed by Taman Bunga in Putatan and Taman Kim Ling in Damai and supply has yet to be restored at press time.

This came just two days after all of Sabah and Labuan were left without electricity for some 10 hours after a fault in one of the two transmission lines between Universiti Malaysia Sabah and Ungun in Sepanggar set in motion what turned out to be a massive blackout.

Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd (SESB) Senior General Manager Muhamad Nazri Pazil, when contacted, said this was an isolated case, which is not connected to the power outage which hit Sabah and Labuan on Friday.

"This is part of our system improvement in progress which is done through stages," he said, adding that he hoped the improvement will see a brighter future ahead.
