Energy Commission Appoints News CEO

Putrajaya, 8 August – The Energy Commission has appointed Abdul Razib Dawood as the new Chief Executive Officer (CEO) effective 1 August 2019. He took over the leadership role from the former CEO, Ir Azhar Omar who retired on 1 April 2019.

Razib Dawood graduated from University of Warwick, United Kingdom (UK) with a Bachelor of Engineering and from University of Manitoba, Kanada with a Master of Science.

He has a vast 25 years of experience in the energy industry, and has assumed key roles in Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) dan Sime Darby Energy Sdn. Bhd., before joining an Australian utility, ElectraNet Pty Ltd as well as Senergy Econnect Australia Pty Ltd.

Razib Dawood later joined the Energy Commission as the Head of Electricity Market Operation Unit from October 2012 to August 2017, before entrusted to be the CEO of Malaysia Nuclear Power Corporation (MNPC) from 2017 to 2018. On 9 April 2018, he was appointed as the Chief Operating Officer (COO) of the Energy Commission.
