# SESB cables damaged after being shot

KOTA KINABALU: Irresponsible action by individuals damaging electrical installations belonging to SESB at Kampung Pangas Ulu early morning on May 11 had caused power outage to 20 houses in the village.

A trace of gunshot was dis-

covered on the Aerial Bundle Cable (ABC) on May 13.

According to the Senior General Manager (Asset Management) SESB, Ir. Ahmad Fuad Md Kasim, electricity supply was fully restored on May 13.

He added that SESB took

longer time to detect and restore the entire electricity supply due to poor weather condition and hazardous road which was unsafe for heavy duty vehicles.
